What do Abortion Pills do? Over half of abortions in the U.S. happen by pregnant women taking a sequence of pills. This is known as "chemical abortion." Its supporters refer to it as "medical abortion" or "medication abortion." Chemical abortion uses two drugs. First, mifepristone (also called by the brand name, Mifeprex, or RU-486) is taken to damage a woman's uterine lining, cutting off nutrition and oxygen to her pre-born child, causing starvation and suffocation. Then, one to two days later, misoprostol is taken to push the baby's remains from the womb. Fortunately, if a woman changes her mind before taking the second drug, the child may be saved about twothirds of the time through an abortion pill reversal process involving the hormone progesterone.
